To support our program, FRN has a local advisory council comprised of a variety of “stakeholders” (parents and primary caregivers) and collaborators from throughout the Natick community, including but not limited to the Natick public schools, the recreation/community services departments, early intervention providers for our region, family child care providers, childcare center/preschool directors, children’s librarians, social service agencies and members of the Natick business community.

The purpose of the Local Council is to further the goals and objectives of the CFCE program in the community context, working to ensure local coordination and maximize local participation in early education and care services and programs, to best serve children and their families in their communities by building upon and linking to the array of existing services in their communities, identifying local gaps in services, and using measures to monitor and improve the delivery of CFCE required services. The council meets 4 times a year.
